Cropping Designs

Cropping your embroidery designs has never been easier with the **Premier+™** Extra and **Premier+™** Modify embroidery programs. Use the Applique and Frame features to crop your embroidery designs. Every design in your library will become a new design when you use these features.

Premier+[™] Extra – Cropping with Frames



- 7. Click Change Hoop.
- 8. Change the Hoop Group to Universal and the Hoop Size to 360 x200 Universal Large Hoop 4. Orientation Rotated.
- 9. Click OK.
- 10. Click on the **Super Design** tab.
- 11. Click on the drop down arrow of the Category box.
- 12. Choose Holidays.
- 13. Click on the drop down arrow of Holidays and choose Holidays2 design 2, Easter Bunny.
- 14. Change the design Size to 100mm.
- 15. Click Apply.
- 16. Right click and use the Duplicate function to create two more designs; a total of 3 designs.
- 17. Place the 3 designs in a line on the screen.
- 18. Select the first design.
- 19. Click the Frame tab in the Ribbon Bar Tab. Choose Classical 2 Frame 5.
- 20. In the Frame Surround box change the Margin to 5mm.



- 21. Check the Group box.
 - This will group the design and frame together.
- 22. Click Apply.
- 23. Select the second design.
- 24. Use the same frame selection.
- 25. Change the Margin to 0mm.
- 26. Click Apply.
- 27. Select the third design.
- 28. Click the Crop button.
- 29. Click Apply.
 - Notice how the frame resizes, however the design does not resize.
 - If the **Combine** command is **not** used you can remove the frame and the cropped design will remain.
- 30. Click the File tab.
- 31. Click New Window.
- 32. Click on the Super Design tab.
- 33. Leave the **Category** box at **Holidays**.
- 34. Choose Holidays 1- design 3, Leprechaun design.
- 35. Change the design Size to 100mm.
- 36. Click Apply.
- 37. Right click on the design and choose Copy.

Border/Applique - Premier+[™] Modify

- 1. Open **Premier+**[™] Modify from the **Quick Link** bar.
- 2. Click Paste.
- 3. At the warning window, click Yes.
- 4. Click on the View tab and uncheck Commands.
 - This will visually remove the color Command dots on the design.
- 5. Select the Border tab.
- 6. Click the Border Shape box.
- 7. Click Shape 2 Circle.
- 8. Click and drag a box in the area of the design that you want to crop.

9. Place your cursor inside the circle.









10. Click and drag the circle to the design area you want to crop if neccesary.

- You can move and resize the circle before you create the border
- 11. Click Create External Border.
 - Try different **Designs, Shapes** and **Frames.** The options and possibilities are endless.
 - The **Frames** and **Applique/Border** are great features to use when you want to keep a design the same size and use just a part of the design.



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
